Friday March 9- \$100

Spend a day in the workshop with a master of modern spindle turning, Willie Simmons. Spindle turning is the foundation for all modern woodturning, and the basis of many woodturning forms including boxes, handles, vases, and hollow forms. Willie's class will spend the morning demonstrating and practicing the most effective and efficient ways to achieve high quality cuts on various timbers. Students will then use these techniques to complete one or two projects in the afternoon session. This class is a great way to learn the best ways to handle various tools or tune up some skills that may have gotten a bit rusty. The class is priced at only \$100 for a full day of turning. The daily fee includes shop fees and practice wood. Each student should end the day with at least one or two completed projects. There may be additional costs for project materials.
