There are three interesting shows of turned objects in Delaware. "Manipulated Turned Object" show is in the gallery Creations, in Yorklyn, Del. (about 15 minutes from Wilmington). This large, curated show includes work by 21 turners and runs through May 30. "Mark Lindquist, Sculptor" at the Delaware Art Museum, Wilmington, through June 20, features eight large bowls and three sculptures. "Art from the Lathe" at the Henry Clay Mill, Hagley Museum, Wilmington, runs through October. This show has pieces from the Woodturning Center collection. This will be near your route if you are driving to the AAW Symposium in Purchase, NY, June 25-27.
