### **Waxed Paper**

Everclear – (Grain alcohol) Useful to cut shellac, clean equipment, antiseptic

## Plumber's Epoxy

Silicone Tape – Sold as "Rescue Tape" and also available from Lee Valley as "High Friction Silicon Tape"

**Gaffer's Tape** – available from 3M and other suppliers. Does not leave a residue on work, unlike some duct tape.

### **Gill Sailing Gloves**

These already have the fingertips cut out. A good pair costs \$25-30, but I got some on eBay for \$5. The newer ones have Kevlar on the palm.

Homemade Sanding Mandrels – (How-to by Joe Ruminski / Stan Wellborn available on request)

Auriou Rasps – These hand-made rasps from France are the best available, better than the #49 and #50 Nicholson cabinet / patternmaking rasps. Available from Highland Woodworking in Atlanta. I prefer the Auriou 8" ALBI #11 and #14 Combination Rasp. Expensive but worth it.
